Pass-Fail Course Request

A student may take a course pass/fail (P/F) only if the course is beyond state graduation requirements in that subject area for the Distinguished, Recommended or Minimum Graduation Plan (whichever plan the student is designated to follow). A student must request P/F status in a course no later than the last instructional day of the sixth week of instruction. A student will not be awarded a numerical grade for the P/F course and it will not be included in the student’s grade-point average. Written approval from the principal, the counselor, the teacher and the parent/guardian are needed for pass/fail status to be granted.
